Medicine Lodge, KS – Barber County United is proud to receive \$8,942 to provide Kansas Leadership Center courses to its coalition partners. The purpose of the Community and Social Context Grant is to provide new opportunities to establish strong community norms for healthier living and learn ways to involve greater access to healthy living options for community members to live better quality lives The grant is made available through Barber County United's collaboration with Pathways to Healthy Kansas an initiative of Blue Cross Blue Shield of Kansas.

The Kansas Leadership Center (KLC) stands by the principle that anyone can lead, anytime, anywhere. When we aspire to build community engagement, create lasting community-wide well-being and cultivate a healthy culture now and for generations to come, everyone in the community must be prepared to exercise leadership. In partnership with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Kansas (BCBSKS), KLC offers Pathways Grantees their choice of opportunities to develop the capacity of their team to lead and create change.

KLC has three distinct programs on the KLC Path that are to be taken in sequential order:

- 1. Your Leadership Edge, a 2-day program.
- 2. Lead for Change, a 4-day program.
- 3. Equip to Lead, a 2-day program.

All three course options are available to attend either virtually or in-person.

Presently, coalition partners from Kiowa District Healthcare, Medicine Lodge Memorial Hospital, Medicine Lodge Peace Treaty Association, and Barber County United have attended Leadership courses.
